Volunteer Signer for Deaf Group

Job Summary

- Volunteer will be under the direction of the Community Development staff, and required to assist Community Development Workers.
- You will be responsible for providing a support service for Deaf adults over 19 years old.
- You will liaise with the Community Development Worker regarding the service and your training needs.
- You will maintain confidentiality at all times.

Key Tasks

- To identify and signpost individuals to other services
- You will maintain a confidential record of sessions. These records will be kept in a secure/locked file in the Community Services Managers' Office.
- You will complete the monitoring and evaluation data as required by the HLC.

You will be DBS cleared at Enhanced level which the Healthy Living Centre will arrange.
